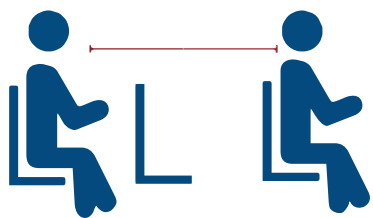


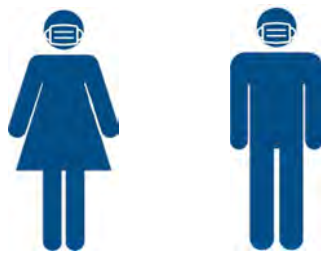
# What We Are Doing

Roosevelt Strategic Council is closely following developments regarding COVID-19. Gov. Ralph Northam announced this week that Northern Virginia will enter Phase 2 of its reopening Friday, June 12 which will allow for 50 people to gather. This number may increase by an unknown variable with the entering of Phase 3 expected within the coming weeks. For now, we wanted to outline some of the precautions we will be taking to have a safe and valuable event for all participants. Precaution methods will be updated in real time according to CDC guidelines



## Social Distant Seating

Seating for all attendees will be placed with limited capacity. This may include only making every other seat available, placing loose seats six feet apart or having seating in multiple rooms depending on the venue.



## Mask Wearing

All attendees and staff will be required to wear a mask during the duration of sessions & where social distancing is not possible during breaks. Appropriate signs will be placed throughout the venue. Speakers will present on a distanced, raised stage & provided appropriate precautions



## Individually Served Food

Pre-packaged, single-serving options will be available for lunch and refreshments instead of buffets. Removal of "high-touch communal items" such as coffee pots.



## No Handshakes

We will ask all event participants to refrain from handshakes.



## Enhanced Cleaning

We will provide extra hand sanitizer along with other disinfectants and hand wash reminders.



## Temperature Check

Infrared thermometers will be used to check guest's temperatures.

Along with the above listed items. All event participants should rest easy knowing RSC will have enhanced end of day cleaning of the meeting space along with temperature checks for staff.

The health and safety of all event participants is our top priority and we will remain in compliance with state guidelines and health precautions as outlined by the CDC.
